RESTAURANTS & CAFÉS

Bridge Street – some of the many restaurants

ASK – Italian Cafe Rouge and Chez Gerard – French Galleria – on the bridge – Italian Las Tasca – Spanish Tapas

In the historic centre

Strada, 17 Trinity Street. Elegant and relaxing. Strada restaurants are famous for their wood oven **pizzas**, but they also have nice salads and good meat and pasta dishes.

The Rainbow, 9a King's Parade (just opposite King's College main entrance, right next door to the National Trust Shop). Excellent vegetarian restaurant also frequented by meat-eaters as the food is delicious (including great cakes!). It provides an excellent choice for vegans and for customers with specific dietary requirements as all food is cooked from fresh ingredients on the premises.

Agora at the Copper Kettle, 4 King's Parade. The old *Copper Kettle* café has been transformed into a full **Turkish** restaurant with a menu and ambience to tantalise the imagination. Friendly staff, delicious menu.

Tatties, 15 Trinity Street. Café restaurant offering **baked potatoes** with a **range of fillings, baguettes, salads and cakes.**

Auntie's Tea Shop, 1 St. Marys Passage. Popular with visitors, jacket potatoes and sandwiches, cakes, scones, alongside assorted teas.

The Eagle, 8 Benet Street (historic pub in town. Very popular with tourists and locals) The well-renowned tale that Crick and Watson are thought to have cracked the double helix structure of DNA, coupled with the RAF bar to the rear of the pub with writing etched into the ceiling with cigarette lighters dating from WWII, makes for interesting history at The Eagle. The pub has lots of nooks and crannies including five rooms, each with their own individual atmosphere, and two bars and a heated beer garden. Variety of food. All tastes are well catered for including vegetarians.

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
