The editors are pleased to announce the **call for posters** for Cambridge Occasional Papers in Linguistics Poster Presentations 2020. For aims, scope, and submission requirements not covered in this call, please refer to the [COPiL website](#).

Interested parties must submit abstracts of up to 500 words (excluding data, tables, figures and bibliography) and comprise no more than two pages in total. Abstracts should include the title of the project and author name(s). Submissions are open to all members of the University of Cambridge. We especially encourage submissions from previously underrepresented areas, e.g. phonetics, pragmatics, language acquisition, computational linguistics, language contact, etc.

We encourage final-year undergraduate students, MPhil students, PhD students, and researchers to submit their work. Authors submitting articles for Volume 12 of COPiL will be automatically accepted for poster presentations but must provide an abstract by the deadline. Amongst other interested parties, we will give preference to undergraduate and masters students.

Abstract submissions may be in either Word (.doc/.docx) or PDF (.pdf) formats.

The deadline for submissions is **16th January 2020**.
