MS WORD GUIDELINES

We strongly encourage authors to submit their manuscripts in `.tex` (L^AT_EX) format with a separate `.bib` file containing the bibliography. Alternatively, authors may submit in `.doc/.docx` formats. Following are some general guidelines:

1. Acknowledgements footnotes should go on the heading of the first section (usually the introduction).
2. Section headings/titles: in general, capitalise only the first word.
3. Captions on tables should end in full stop. Leave out vertical lines for tables (unless absolutely necessary). For empty cells, use a single solid line `-`.
4. Use single quotes `'` rather than double `"`.
5. Any citation style is acceptable although APA is recommended. Cite consistently throughout the paper.
