

REGULATIONS FOR ALL MML IA & IB, Sp06 AND SP10 (CATALAN) ORAL EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Oral Examinations are University Examinations, and the date or time of an individual oral examination may only be changed *in exceptional circumstances*.
- 2. Exceptional circumstances which are considered acceptable reasons for applying to change the schedule include:
 - a) medical grounds, supported by a doctor's certificate
 - b) personal or family crises, supported by a letter from the candidate's Tutor or Senior Tutor
 - c) observance of religious festivals.
- 3. Applications for a candidate to be examined at other times than those previously advertised due to the reasons quoted under Point 2 above must be made (enclosing any supporting evidence) via the candidate's Tutor (or Senior Tutor) to the Secretary of the Board of Examinations at exam.arrangements@admin.cam.ac.uk, with copy to the Secretary for Oral A & B and Sp10 exams, Mina Perkins/Kristina Petruskeviciute <oralab@mmll.cam.ac.uk>. Once the Board of Examinations and the Oral A and B / Sp10 Senior Examiner approve the change of date of the exam for the candidate, the Oral A & B Examinations Secretary will liaise with relevant examiners to reschedule the exam to a suitable date.
- 4. On no account may a student, Director of Studies, or Tutor, make any direct arrangement with individual examiners for a change in the Oral Examination schedule.
- 5. If the Board of Examinations, in consultation with the Chair of Examiners, give permission for a candidate to be examined at a time other than that previously advertised, the examination shall take place either before the original time, or as soon as possible thereafter, and in any case within a period specified by the Chair of Examiners which, barring the most exceptional of circumstances, shall not exceed two weeks from the previously advertised date.
- 6. Any candidate who fails to attend an oral examination without a valid reason, who does not follow the procedure outlined above or who, having failed to attend, is subsequently refused permission to take the oral examination at a time other than that previously advertised, shall be given a mark of zero for that component of his/her Examinations.
